February Food Drive: The collection of certain food items to be given primarily to Topeka North Outreach. Volunteer to bring food items, help sort or deliver items.

ShareFest Topeka: Serve alongside other Northlanders and other Churches in Topeka to serve our community on a Saturday morning set in the spring. Northland's serving has been primarily at the Topeka Rescue Mission Facilities. You may also serve on the leadership team in helping to organize our serving project.

Baby Bottle Fundraiser. Obtain a Northland provided baby bottle for collecting of change to support one our ministries. Fundraising is done from Mother's Day to Father's Day. You may also volunteer to prepare, distribute and collect baby bottles during the campaign.

Operation Christmas Child. In the fall Northland will distribute Shoeboxes so you may fill them with prescribed items to be sent to children all over the world. An individual, family or small group may serve by filling their own box(es), serving at the packing party where together we fill many shoeboxes, collecting boxes (as we are the local collection location) or be a part of a trip to the Denver packing facility.

TNO Christmas Families. Adopt a family, families or an individual for Christmas to provide gifts and food to those who are struggling during the Christmas season. This can be done by an individual, a family or a small group. An opportunity to bless people in our own community during the Christmas season.

MISSION TRIPS

Living Water International-Honduras. A yearly trip in the first quarter of the year to Honduras. The team will drill for fresh water in a community, teach hygiene to children and families and bring the Living Water to the Honduras communities.

Village of Hope-Guatemala. A trip to Guatemala in July to serve at an orphanage and the surrounding communities. Occasionally we will have a men's trip in February. Our team pours into the staff, families and the facilities at Village of Hope who are ministering to children without homes and/or families.

India. There will be occasional opportunities to travel to India and be a part of our supported ministries in India. Ministering to children, to people in the slums, leper colonies, church plants or to disciple and train new church leaders. Usually will be a 10 day trip and may in conjunction with Fellowship Bible Church.
